





Plus, superior engineering is apparent in design innovations such as 16-foot runs without return panels, unbalanced overhead storage, and extruded aluminum trim that remains straight and true, even as workspace reconfigurations occur over time. Intelligent power options provide access at the base, above and below the worksurface, or port power to a custom location on the panel. It's your choice.









Compose glass panel frames allow the balance of privacy with individual views. Low-gloss, double-cut veneers showcase a sophisticated horizontal grain and complement the linear flow of the architecture—and they can be used to effectively communicate status. Important details, such as architectural raceway covers or tiles that extend to the floor give new options for cleaner aisles and office interiors.

What's more, the Haworth Surface Collection lets you choose among sophisticated colors, textures, and patterns. And the enhanced offering from the Haworth+ program includes approved systems fabrics from Carnegie, Luna Textiles, and Maharam, maximizing your choices.


Four-inch-thick Enclose walls integrate seamlessly with three-inch-thick Compose panels, to maintain a proportional scale throughout. What's more, Enclose incorporates the same strict attention to

detail, such as clean reveals, to ensure design continuity extends from wall to panel and tile.

When Compose and Enclose are used together, private offices, collaborative spaces and the open plan become a readily adaptable, cohesive whole. Providing for every level of privacy and hierarchy is simplified without straying from the overarching design intent.


Throughout its lifecycle, Compose is designed to minimize its impact on the environment and create healthier workspaces. Nearly 70% of its components can be recycled, including all of the aluminum trim and slat tiles. Wood finishes are water based, to minimize the emission of VOC's into the atmosphere. And durable powder coatings don't release the pollutants associated with traditional paints.

But perhaps the most important contribution Compose can make is through adaptability. As a company evolves, Compose can be reconfigured again and again, yet maintain its integrity and durability. The floorplate can be transformed in unlimited ways, as tiles are easily removed, refabricated, and reused. The Compose system reduces waste and increases your return on investment.





Power and data can be accessed above or below the worksurface, at the base or standing height, or ported to custom locations to match individual user needs.

A choice of worksurface supports, including P Leg, adjustable disk base, double leg, Planes single leg, or support panel, extend your design freedom.


Compose benching extends the possibilities of a single system. Use as touchdown stations or to support mobile teams and distributed workers in densely populated areas.



Options such as a light-scale knife edge, wood trim, and a monolithic wood tile, extend planning possibilities—as does seamless integration with other Haworth products, such as the X Series® Active Storage


Side-independent panel frames allow monolithic tiles on one side and segmented tiles on the other, to balance aesthetic and facility objectives. Add a sliding door to enhance individual privacy.

For a cleaner aesthetic, specify laminate tiles to the floor with no raceway cover. Simple, clean lines without extraneous details support workstyles without distraction.
