Central to its design is the padded duvet that covers the armchair like a jacket—easily replaced to suit personal tastes and seasonality. A model for upcycling, the entire chair may be recycled and is made from recyclable materials—giving renewed value to materials.

Mexique

Included as one of the *en forme libre* tables created between 1938 and 1939, the final design was developed in 1952 for students' rooms at the Maison du Mexique at the Cité Universitaire Internationale in Paris. With its compact frame, Mexique tables can be juxtaposed to create larger, symmetrical units. The collection also includes occasional tables, bar-height tables, and coordinating stools.

Designed by Vico Magistretti, this simple, elegant bookcase has been an undisputed design icon since 1977. Nuvola Rossa is also a genuine invention in terms of construction: diagonal bracing struts provide both the support structure and housing for the shelves, eliminating the need for side supports. Nuvola Rossa can also be folded away completely.
